Course



A five day introductory professional development course for doctors, nurses, paramedics and other health care professionals who currently work in patient air transport systems, or those who wish to do so. The objective of the course is to give a thorough foundation in the art and science of retrieval and transport medicine. It addresses relevant issues of the special physical, physiological and psychological stresses that are important in the various transport environments, and describes the conditions which are susceptible during transfers by land and by air, and how patients may be safely and efficiently carried.
